BEE DISEASES INSURANCE

Bee Diseases Insurance (BDI) does not apply for Junior or Associate categories.

For all other categories Bee Diseases Insurance cover for up to 3 colonies is included in your basic subscription and is mandatory.

BDI cover for more than 3 colonies will require an additional premium to be paid. When working out how many colonies you need BDI cover for, it is important to consider the **maximum** number of colonies that you are likely to have at any one time during the year and insure for that number. For example, if you over-wintered two colonies, they will expand in the spring and summer and you may find you have to split them, resulting in four colonies in summer, even if you are not planning increase or collecting swarms.

Should the worst happen and you have bee disease problems, when the Bee Inspector examines your colonies, you will have to show your BDI certificate if you need to claim compensation, **and if you do not have enough cover for all the colonies, wherever they are, your insurance will be invalid.**

Even more seriously, if you share an apiary and are under-insured, you invalidate the Insurance cover for all the other beekeepers' colonies in that apiary too.

Members with hives in Divisional Apiaries **must** be fully insured with BDI at all times.

The table below shows the additional premium you need to pay for each range of colonies. Full colonies and nucleus colonies count for BDI purposes, but mini-nucs do not.
