Beekeeping notes for July:

July Forage:

- Watch out for the 'nectar gap' from June to the end of August, depending on weather conditions.
- Bees will be focusing on collecting pollen and nectar from summer flowering plants that include; Anise Hyssop, Borage, Chives, Lavender, Hebe, Motherwort, Lime Tree and Valerian to name a few!

Beware Swarms!

- Have equipment for artificial swarming ready
- Have equipment and nucs ready for receiving swarms!

July tasks:

- Complete regular, weekly inspections specifically looking for queen cells and disease
- Monitor and treat for Varroa (if Supers are on, non-chemical treatments)
- Be mindful of food shortages after removing honey stores and approaching the 'nectar gap'
- Deter wasps and robbers that will be looking for sugary-stores and food!

Divisional Library:
